

CMPS 121 – Final Demo Guidelines

Overview

Your group will be presenting the final status of the application, and demonstrating the use of the app either on a real Android device or the Android emulator.

Details

Your demo should be 4 minutes or less, and all members should take part in the final demo. In your demo, you will be covering the following topics (not necessarily in this order):

- What is the purpose of your application?
- Who will use your application?
- Demonstrate the use of your application, showing the app open, and the all Activities that will be transitioned to when user interaction takes place.

Your demo should be in video form, and it will be up to your group how exactly you end up recording your demo. Here are some suggestions:

- Record the screen of your computer (if you're using an emulator) or the screen of your Android device with a voice-over of your group members describing the use of the app.
- Using a video camera (this could even be someone's computer's built-in webcam), record the use of the Android app (or emulator) by your group members.

Your video will not be judged by production quality but rather by the quality of your app demo.

Turning it in

Upload your video file to Google Drive, set the sharing options such that anyone with the link can view the video. Verify that your video will play in Drive (by playing your video in your browser). Your video should be in one of the following formats: WebM, 3GPP, MPEG4, MOV, AVI, MPEGPS, WMV, FLV, MTS, OGG. Submit the link to your video in Canvas. All videos will be made public to the class (no later than the week after finals week) so that everyone can see the interesting projects that have been made throughout the quarter!

Rubric

Your demo will be graded out of 10 points, with the following criteria being covered in your video:

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| • Application purpose. | 2pts |
| • Application users. | 2pts |
| • Application opening screen. | 2pts |
| • Transitions to app's activities (via user interaction). | 2pts |
| • App is operating with minimal bugs and crashes. | 2pts |

Group members not taking part in the final demo will not receive credit for this assignment.
